

Itinerary for the day.

10am - Arrive and meet up with the farm presenter. Gather in the welcome area to get wellies and outside clothes on and learn how to have safe fun on a farm.

10:15am - Head out for the first activity of the day. This is the animal experience where we take a tour of the farm and meet all the fascinating animals including farm animals, pet animals, exotic animals and even some creepy crawlies. The animal interaction areas are undercover so a little rain won't dampen our fun.

11:30am - We will go to the classroom and have a drink of water and snack.

11:40am - We will learn about the different types of food that are grown on farms and how different seeds grow into different crops. This is all age appropriate and everyone gets to have a go at planting their own crops in pots that can be taken back to school and used for further learning.

12:30pm - Everyone gets washed up at the washing area and toilet block and heads over to the enclosed picnic area.

1pm - We look at what different animals like to eat. We get together all their different foods and investigate more closely what is in them and how they are similar/different to the foods we eat. We will then move around the farm and feed all the different animals.

1:45pm - We take a trip to the adjoining farm shop where there is an opportunity to see all the produce grown locally on sale. Children will not require spending money.

2pm - We all get washed up and head back to the coach to return to school.
