## Year 4 Grafham Experience

Dear Parent/Carer,

As the Grafham visit is nearly here and the main organisation and preparations are now complete, this is the final reminder of key information following the meeting with parents last week.

As requested, another copy of the kit list has been attached and we ask that you pack the bag with your child. The British weather will, of course, be unpredictable, so could you please ensure your child has enough warm clothes to layer up and take off to suit any changes in weather. Please do not send expensive new clothing. Children will need strong outdoor footwear that can get wet, an old pair of shoes to wear when in the canoes, trainers and slippers or similar to wear in the lounge areas. A few plastic bags would also be useful for wet or muddy clothing.

Children are asked to come to school at the normal time and leave their bags in the Small Hall. Any required medication should be clearly labelled with name, dosage and time to be taken. This should be handed over to the member of staff in the Small Hall. Medication must be in the original packaging. Registration will be at 8:45 a.m. as usual but will be in the Pumas classroom.

The coach will be leaving school at 9:40 a.m. on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> March and is due to leave Grafham at approximately 2:30 p.m. on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> March. As we travel back to school, we will send a text to parents when we have passed through Spittles Interchange at Huntingdon. Expected return is 3:15 p.m. when children will be taken back into school ready for collection. We ask that you use the Community entrance when coming to collect your child.

Should they wish to do so children are allowed to buy souvenirs costing up to £5:00. Children will be able to see the items on arrival. I have attached the price list of items available for your information. If possible, please send coins in a sealed envelope with the order form and give to the member of staff on arrival. The Centre will be holding a cake stall in aid of Comic Relief so children may have an opportunity to buy a small cake/treat.

Children will be expected to help clear the dinner table after each meal, and make their own bed, including putting on duvet covers and sheets, so it may be helpful for some to practise this over the coming week.
